

WALK 6

This walk is suitable for pedestrians only. Wellies in winter, strong shoes in summer.

Time: approx 1.5 hours.

Distance: approx 3 miles.

Starting point is at Bentfield Upper Green (A).

Turn left and walk south towards Bentfield Causeway turning right at signpost (B) between a barn and cottage onto FP8. Climb over stile and across the next field to join a well defined cart track leading to Lime Kiln Lane.

Turn right at the lane and left at the junction to Hole Farm. Walk through the gate onto FP7 at the signpost, then along what appears to be a ditch between the farm buildings and a pond. Climb the bank at the far end (C). Walk in a westerly direction across the field towards the southern corner of Netherhills Plantation and then bear right (north) on FP34. Cross the River Stort by wooden footbridge and follow FP11 Farnham to Hazel End Road, emerging at Manuden Lodge.

Turn left here and walk along Hazel End Road to the pond next to The Three Horseshoes pub (*take care as there is no pavement here*).

Turn left onto FP12 Farnham and walk along the northern side of the cricket field, meeting the lane at the corner just west of Watermill Farm. Turn right onto FP58, cross the field to Lime Kiln Lane, continue on the other side as FP10 to the south western corner of Blythwood Gardens. Turn left on FP11, walk along the back of the houses to Bentfield Road, turn left and left again into Bentfield Causeway and back to your starting point.
