

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Essex County Council (Church Road, Stansted) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2022

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council intends, not less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make the above Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the order: To temporarily close that length of Church Road, Stansted in the District of Uttlesford, from its junction with Lower Street to its junction with Watson Way a distance of approximately 736m.

The closure is scheduled to commence on 25th May 2022 for 3 days, or where stated on a valid permit (EP201EH2321228 - Essex County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [one.network](#).

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while drainage works are undertaken by Essex County Council.

An alternative route is available via Church Road, Walson Way, Forest Hall Road, Stansted Road, Pines Hill, Silver Street, Chapel Hill and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The Order will come into effect on 5th May 2022 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
